


# Feast of All Saints

*The Baptismal Covenant*

*Presider:* Together, in the company of all the saints, let us recommit ourselves to Christ and renew our baptismal covenant.

Do you believe in God the Father?

*All:* **I believe in God, The Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.**

*Presider:* Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

*All:* **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.**

*Presider:* Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

*All:* **I believe in God the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.**

*Presider:* Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

*Presider:* Will you persevere in resisting evil and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

*Presider:* Will you proclaim by word and example the good news of God in Christ?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

*Presider:* Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbour as yourself?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

*Presider:* Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

*Presider:* Will you strive to safeguard the integrity of God's creation, and respect, sustain and renew the life of the Earth?

*All:* **I will, with God's help.**

### ***Prayers of the People***

#### ***Peace***

*Presider:* May the peace of Christ be with you all.

*All:* **And also with you.**

#### ***Prayer of Lament***

*Presider:* In union, blessed Jesus, with the faithful gathered at every altar of your Church where your blessed Body and Blood are offered, we long to offer you praise and thanksgiving, for creation and all the blessings of this life, for the redemption won for us by your life, death, and resurrection, for the means of grace and the hope of glory.

We believe that you are truly present in the Holy Sacrament, and, since we cannot at this time receive communion, we pray you to come into our hearts. We unite ourselves with you and embrace you with all our hearts, our souls, and our minds. Let nothing separate us from you; let us serve you in this life until, by your grace, we come to your glorious kingdom and unending peace. Amen.

#### ***Lord's Prayer***

*Presider:* As our Saviour taught us, let us pray,

*All sing:* **Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Save us from the time of trial, and deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.**
